

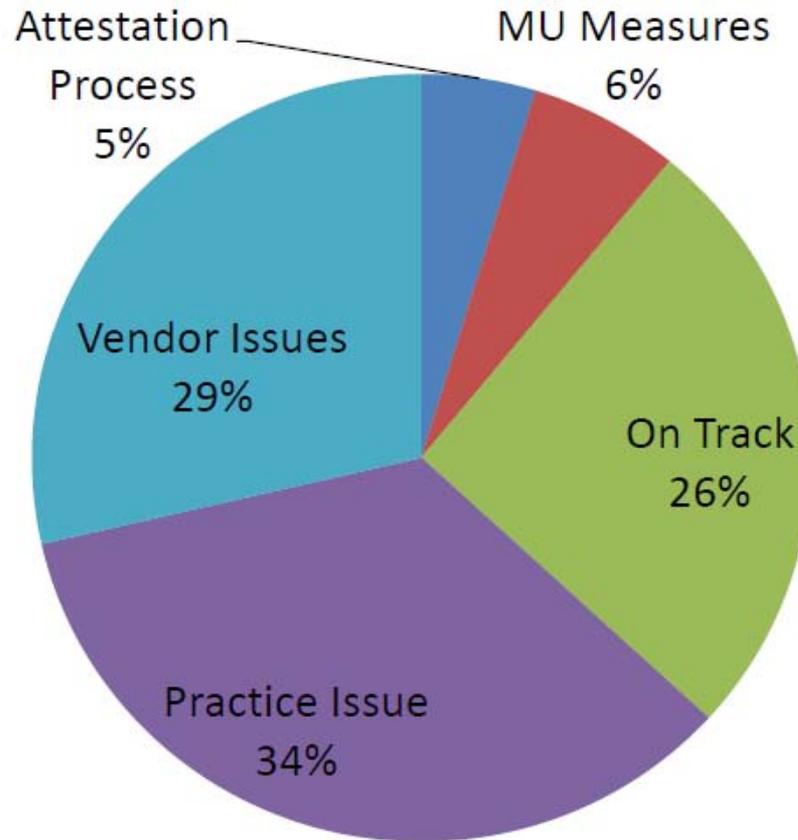
REC Reported Practice Level Barriers to Achieving Meaningful Use

Preliminary Data generated on
January 10, 2012

Background:

- In an effort to accelerate the number of providers that are receiving Meaningful Use payments in 2012, ONC asked RECs to voluntarily begin tracking practice level barriers in the CRM tool, during the ONC annual meeting.
- New fields were created for the CRM, that asked RECs to identify
 - 1) If the practice was planning on applying for Medicaid (AIU) or Medicare EHR Incentive funds
 - 3) projected date MU attestation date, and
 - 2) any barriers that the practice was encountering.
- To encourage RECs to describe what practices were facing, ONC only provided a few broad categories initially to classify the barriers. ONC is now analyzing the barriers that were identified to develop more detailed sub categories. This will be an on-going iterative process and ONC welcomes any/all feedback.
- ONC is exploring identifying resources that could be used to address priorities that are impacting

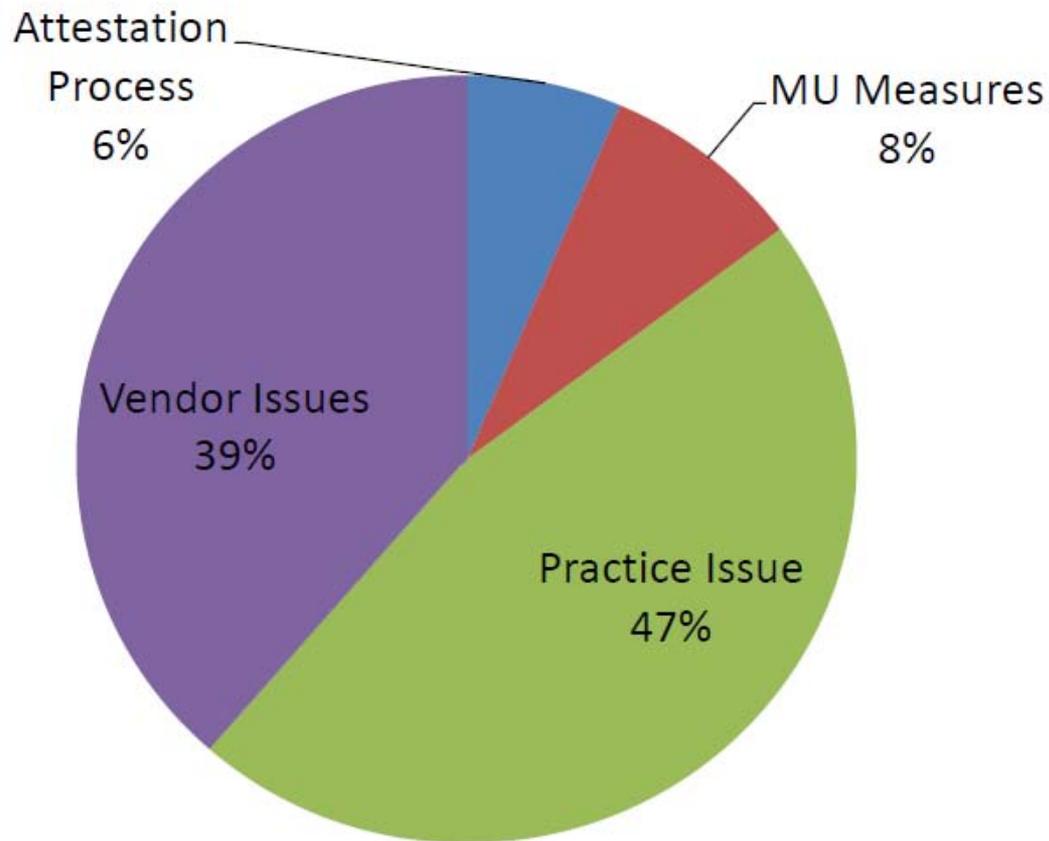
Number of Barriers by Type as Reported in CRM

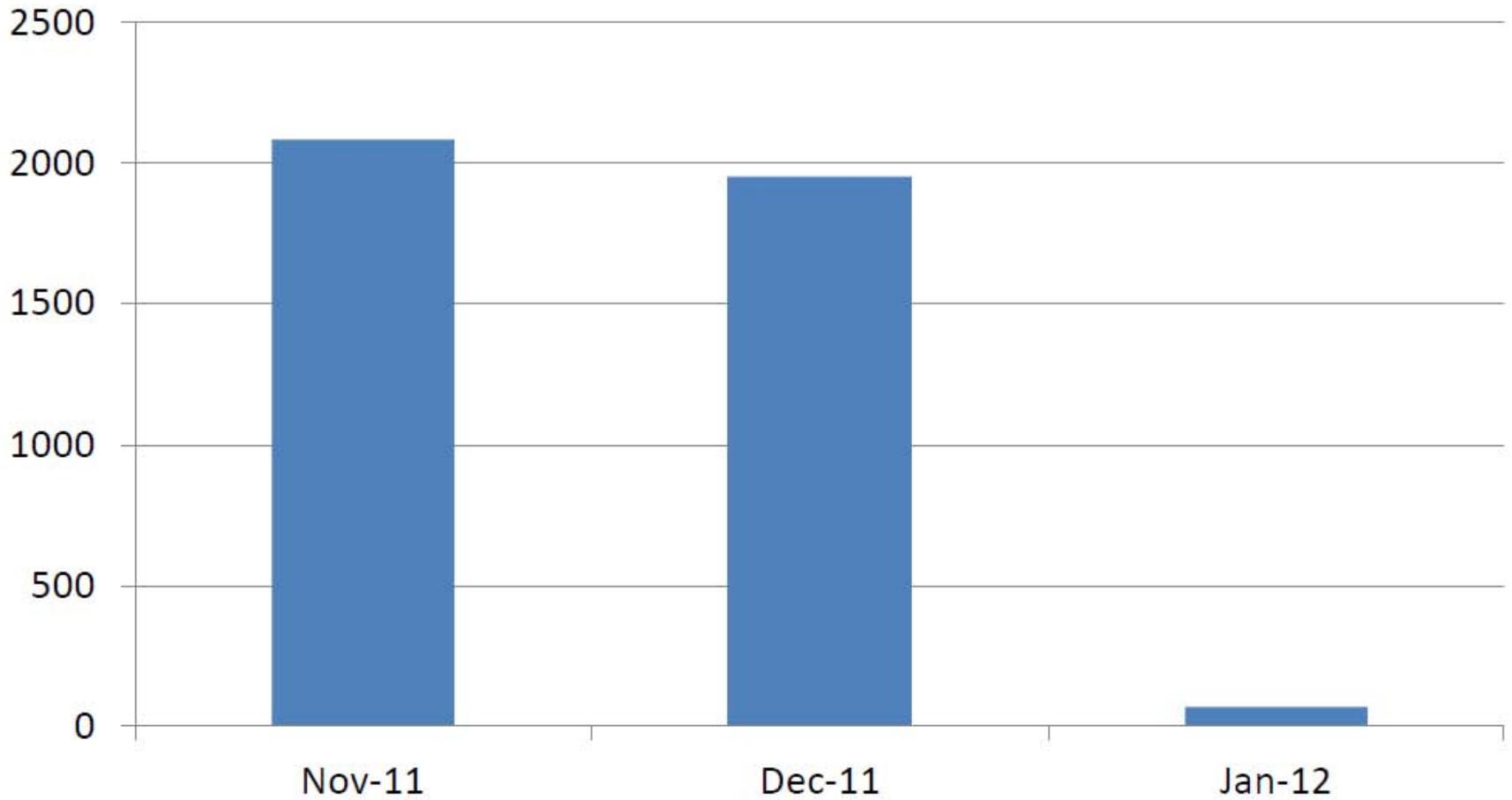
Number of Barriers by Type as Reported in CRM

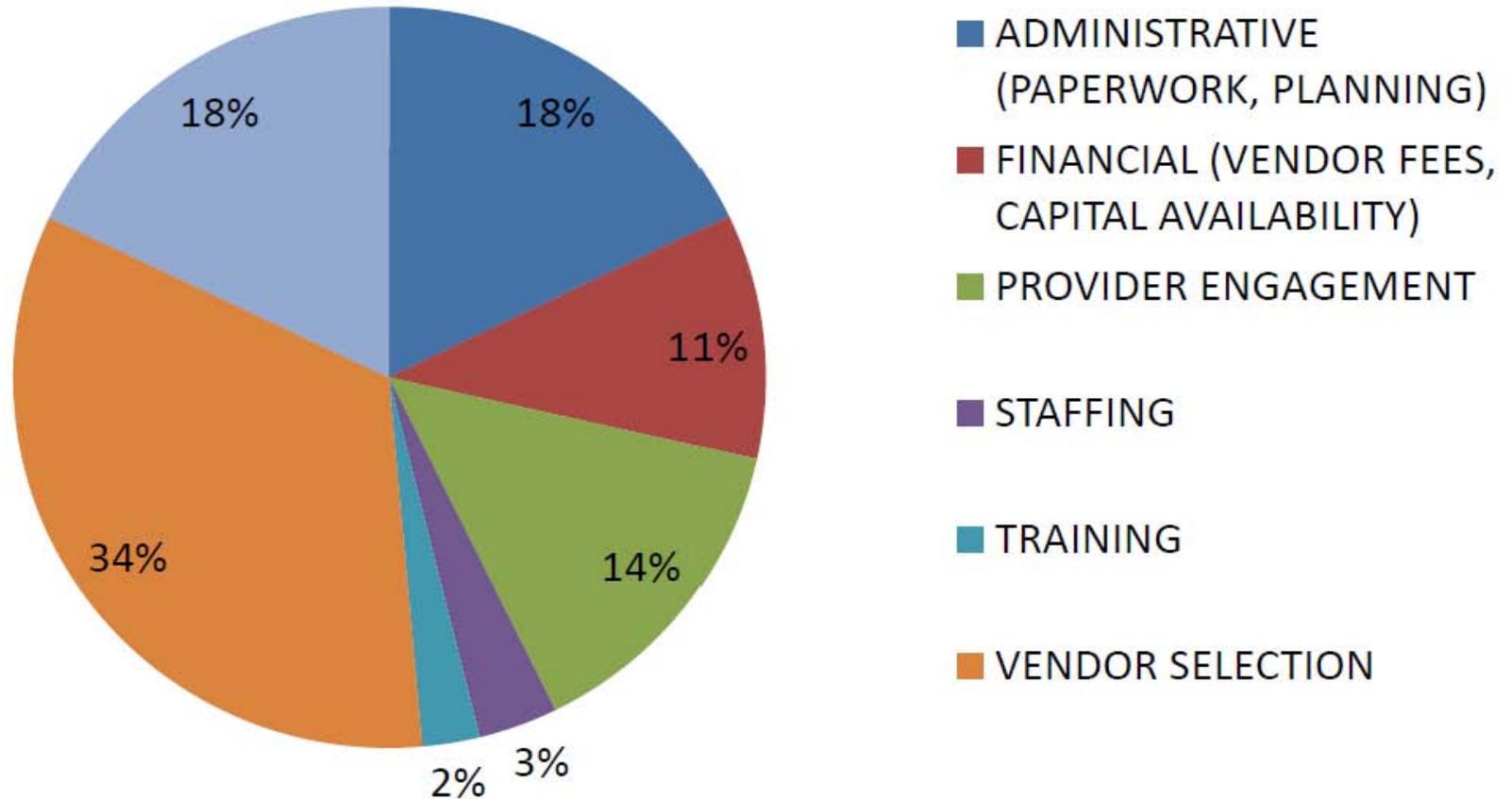

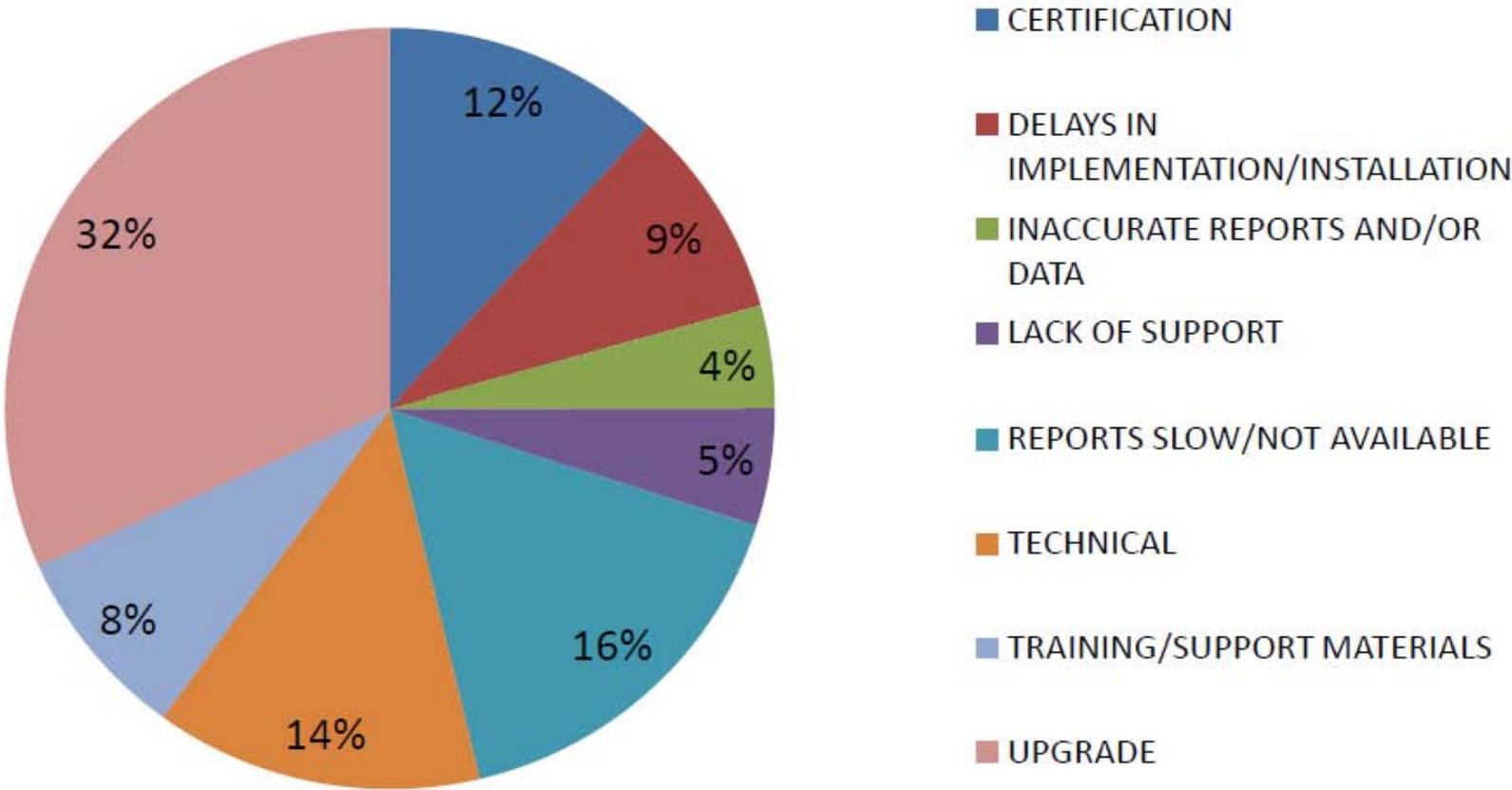
Practice Issue Barrier Categories

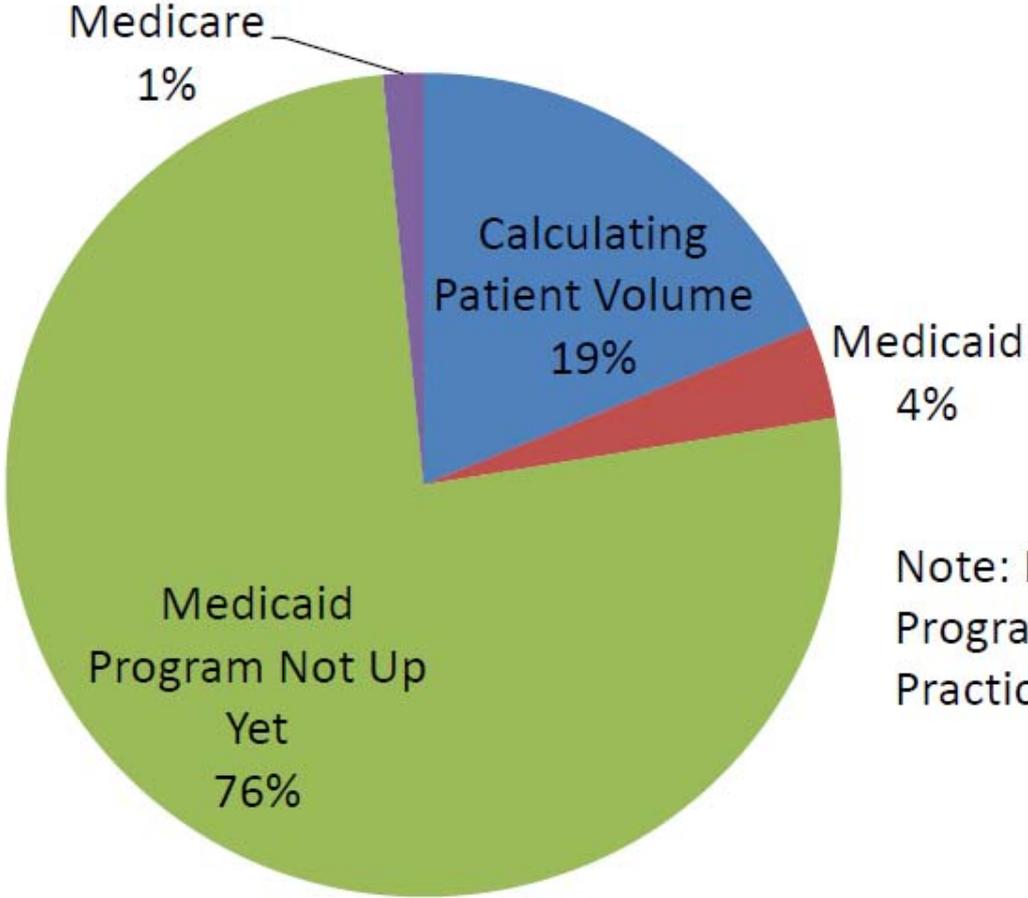
